Beginning Neon Art **10/21/09 to 11/11/09**

This course is designed for the student that has been previously introduced to the basic skills in the fabrication of neon. Students will work on a simple project that involves heating, bending, welding and annealing glass tubing using a ribbon burner, cannon fire and tipping torch. Students will practice the bending process for the four basic bends: 90 degree, right angle, double back, "U", and "O" loop for the understanding of a simple radius bend. **Cost \$395.** 4 class meetings with all materials included. Class limited to 4 students. Wednesday, 7pm to 9:30pm. Instructor: Louis "Tony" Curiel.

About Instructor Louis "Tony" Curiel

Louis (Tony) Curiel is a world-class neon-glass blowing craftsman that has won many honors and awards within the industry of glass art. He began his career in glass art in the early 1970s and has studied and worked along side some of the pioneers in the art form. He moved his neon glass blowing studios from Detroit to Spencer in 2007. He is the Director of the CRVA.
