

4-H Sew Inspired Teams Invited to Fashion Show

The Clay County 4-H program is pleased to announce that participants from the “Sew Inspired” fashion design event will be presented with a unique opportunity to be a part of a fashion show thanks to a partnership with the Curiel/Reynolds School of Visual Arts.

Up to twelve county teams will be participating in the September 11 fashion event called “Sew Inspired” at the 4-H Auditorium during the Clay County Fair. Teams will be constructing a new outfit inspired by the fashions of the 1950’s from two formal gowns. The gowns for this event were donated by A Heavenly Celebration in Emmetsburg.

At least four of the most creative and inspiring “Sew Inspired” fashion designs will be invited to send their model to the Curiel/Reynolds School of Visual Arts “Vintage to Vogue” Fashion Show and Benefit on September 25th at the CRVA Auditorium in Spencer. The spectacular Runway Show will feature one-of-a-kind fashions from Iowa's new Zsa Zsa and Eva clothing line and local artisans furnish jewelry and other wearable art.

Models from the 4-H program will have an opportunity to show their team’s fashion design in a runway show early in the evening prior to the headlining fashion runway show.

“The concept of linking vintage fashion with modern fashion design is a common thread between these two events. This invitation is giving us the ability to offer our 4-Hers from around the state an opportunity to experience something unique,” said Bonnie Dalager, ISU Extension Clay County Program Director.
